Glycerine (Chemical name: <i>1,2,3-Propanetriol</i>)	Used as moisturiser, emulsifier and stabiliser, E422
PEG-40 Hydrogenated Castor Oil (chemical name: Castor oil, hydrogenated)	Vegetable oil (fragrance, emulsifier, surfactant)
Sodium Coceth Sulfate	Emulsifier, surfactant and foam agent. May cause allergies and hypersensitivity. Can cause rashes
Triethanolamine (Chemical name: <i>2,2',2''-Nitrilotriethanol</i>)	Used as pH stabiliser
Acrylates/C10-30 Alkyl Acrylate Crosspolymer	Thickening agent
Parfum (Fragrance)	Perfume
Echium plantagineum	The oil from the plant softens the skin
Cardiospermum halicacabum	Extracts from the plant softens the skin
Helianthus annuus	Sunflower oil, emollient, occlusive
Tocopheryl Acetate (Chemical name: <i>2H-1-Benzopyran-6-ol, 3,4-dihydro-2,5,7,8-tetramethyl-2-((4R,8R)-4,8,12-trimethyltridecyl)-, acetate, (2R)-rel-</i>)	Vitamin-E, used as an antioxidant and for easing irritation
Retinyl Palmitate	Vitamin-A, skin conditioning
Octyldodecanol (chemical name: <i>1-Dodecanol, 2-octyl-</i>)	Solvent, fragrance, emollient
Aloe barbadensis Gel	Used for its healing effect
Sodium Benzotriazolyl Butylphenol Sulfonate (chemical name: <i>Benzenesulfonic acid, 3-(2H-benzotriazol-2-yl)-4-hydroxy-5-(1-methylpropyl)-, monosodium salt</i>)	UV-blocker
Buteth-3	Solvent
Tributyl Citrate (chemical name: <i>1,2,3-Propanetricarboxylic acid, 2-hydroxy-, 1,2,3-tributyl ester</i>)	Plasticiser, solvent, film former
DMDM Hydantoin (chemical name: <i>1,3-Bis(hydroxymethyl)-5,5-dimethylimidazolidine-2,4-dione</i>)	Preservative
Tetrasodium EDTA (Chemical name: Acetic acid, (ethylenedinitrilo)tetra-, tetrasodium salt)	Chelating agent– forms complexes with metal ions in water and makes the wa- ter "soft", so it is easier to make a foam
PEG-12 Dimethicone (chemical name: <i>Dimethylpolysiloxane</i>)	Silicone oil, viscosity adjuster and skin conditioner

Limonene (Chemical name: *(1)-1-Methyl-4-(1-methylvinyl)cyclohexene*)Fragrance, known to be an allergenic

Linalool (Chemical name: *(1)-3,7-Dimethyl-1,6-octadien-3-ol*).....Fragrance found naturally in lavender, known to be an allergenic

CI 42051 (Acid Blue 3) (chemical name: *C.I. Acid Blue 3, calcium salt (2:1) (8CI)*) Colour, blue

CI 47005 (Food Yellow 13) (chemical name: *C.I. Acid Yellow 3*)Colour, yellow
